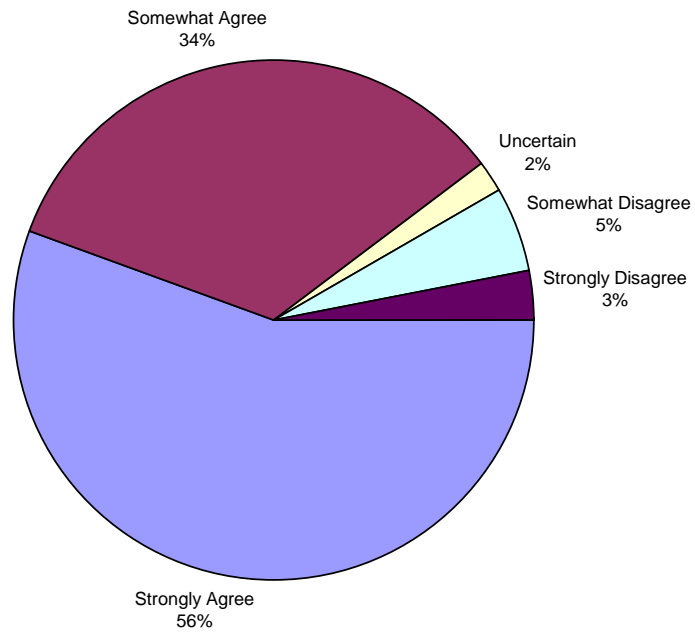


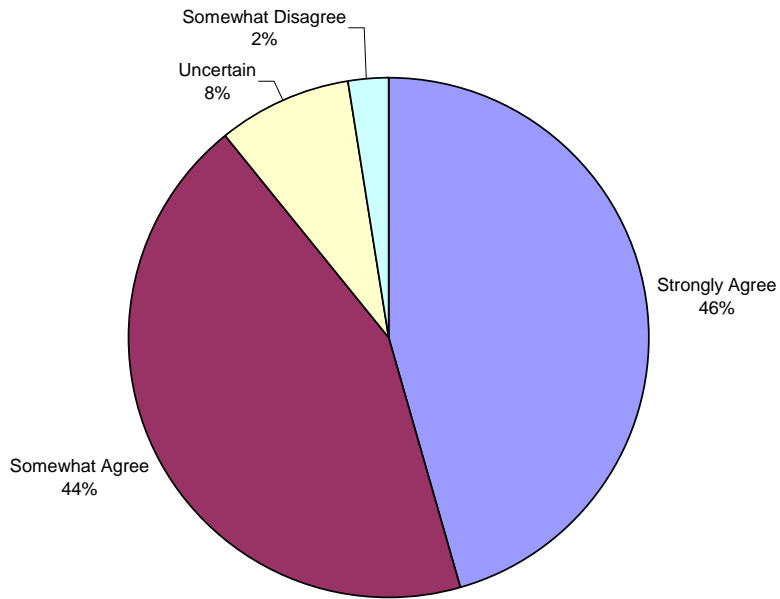

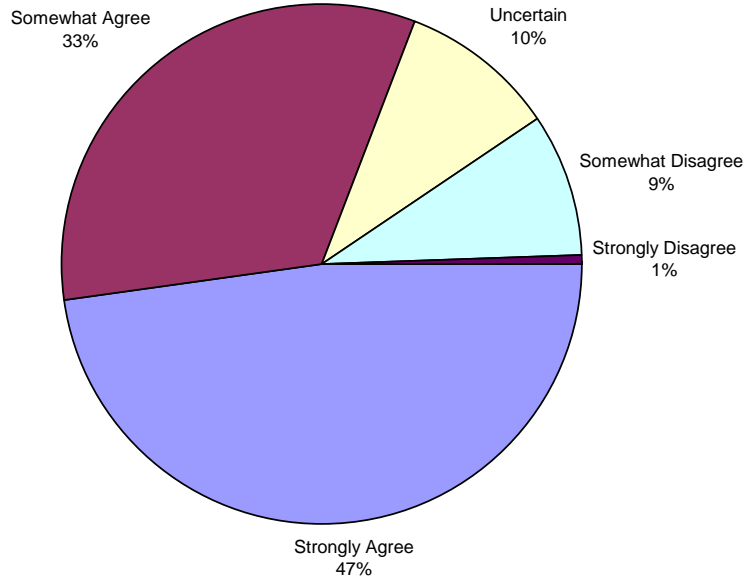
In my judgment most other people I know are happy with what they experience at St. Thomas .



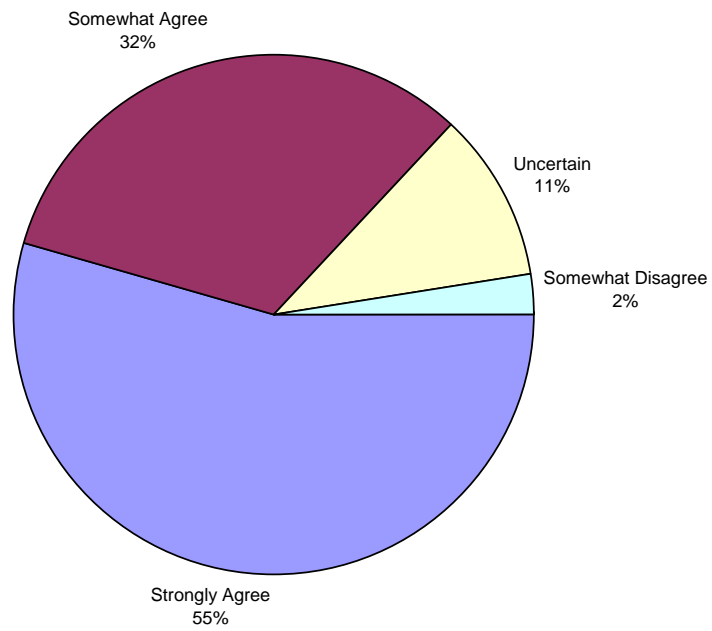
St. Thomas Aquinas offers a good balance of activities and programs for all parishioners



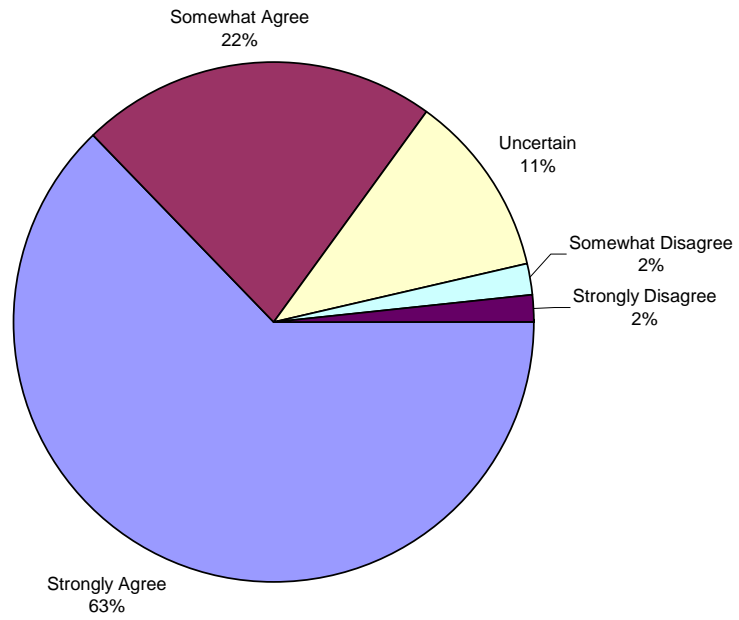
There is a strong sense of community among St. Tom's parishioners



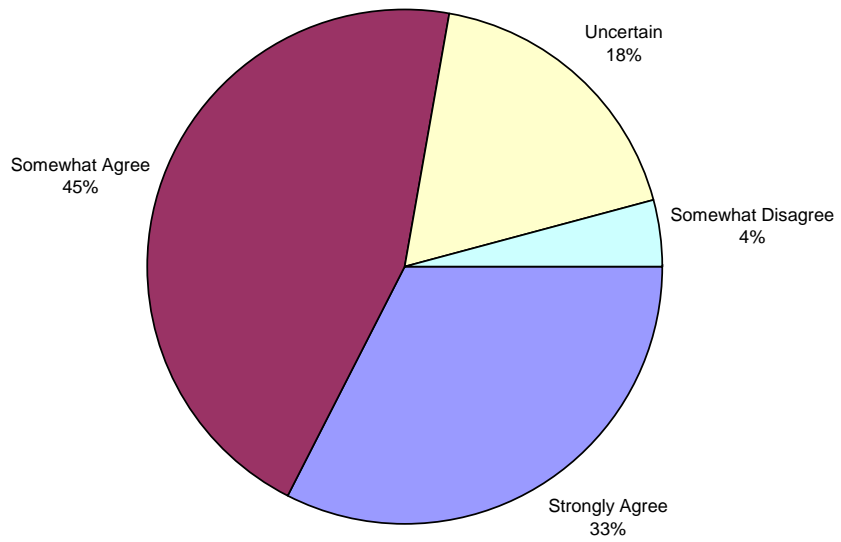
The Pastoral staff is responsive to the needs of the parishioners



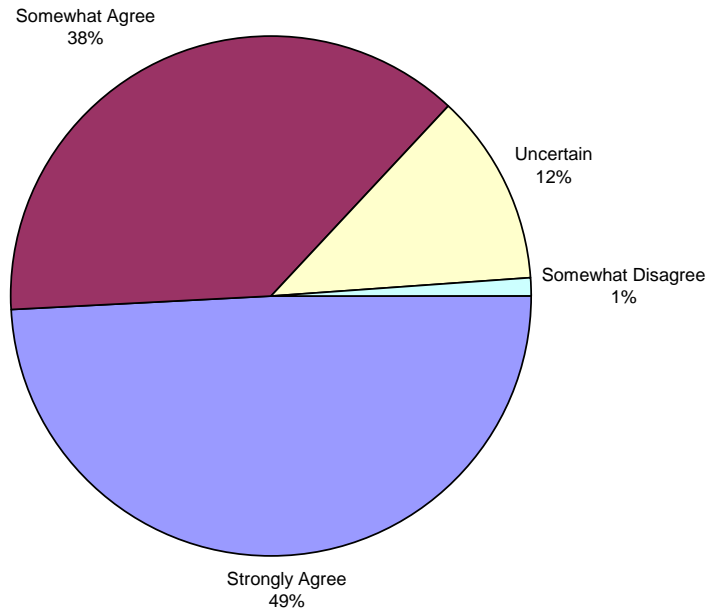
The involvement of the Dominican clergy has been a good fit with the St. Thomas Aquinas



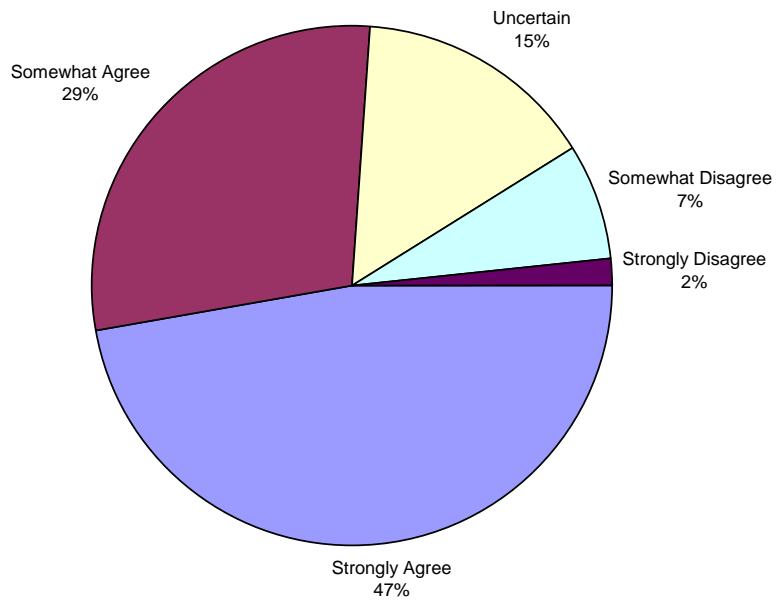

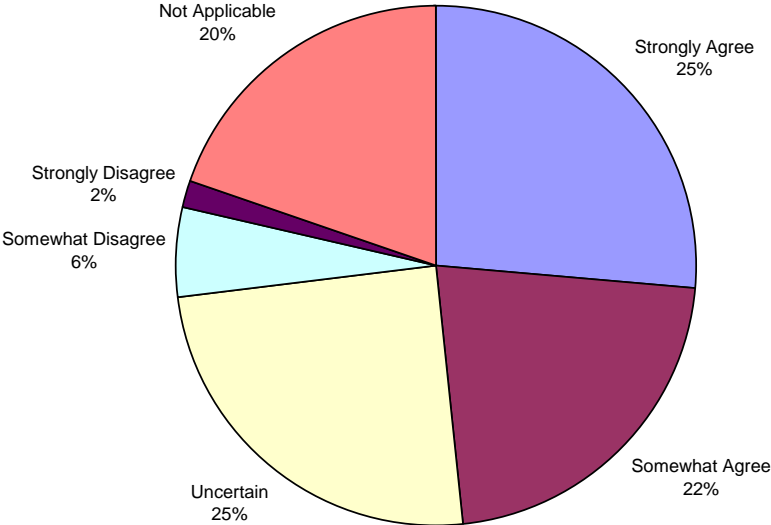
During the winter the quality of the church's heating significantly detracts from prayer and active participation in the liturgy



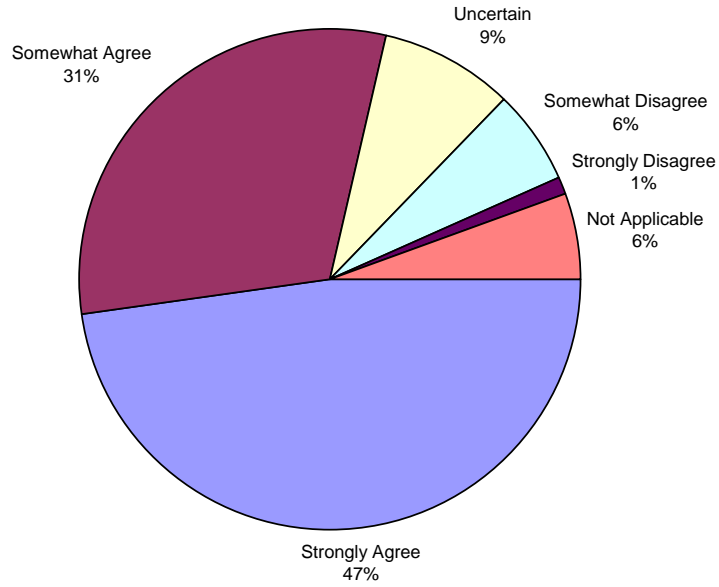
During the summer the lack of air conditioning significantly detracts from prayer and active participation in the liturgy



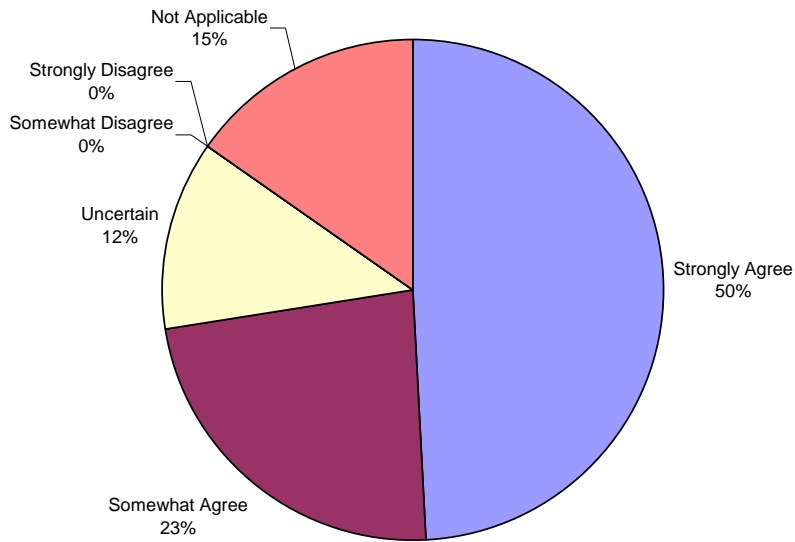
I am satisfied with the types and variety of religious education programs offered Purdue University students



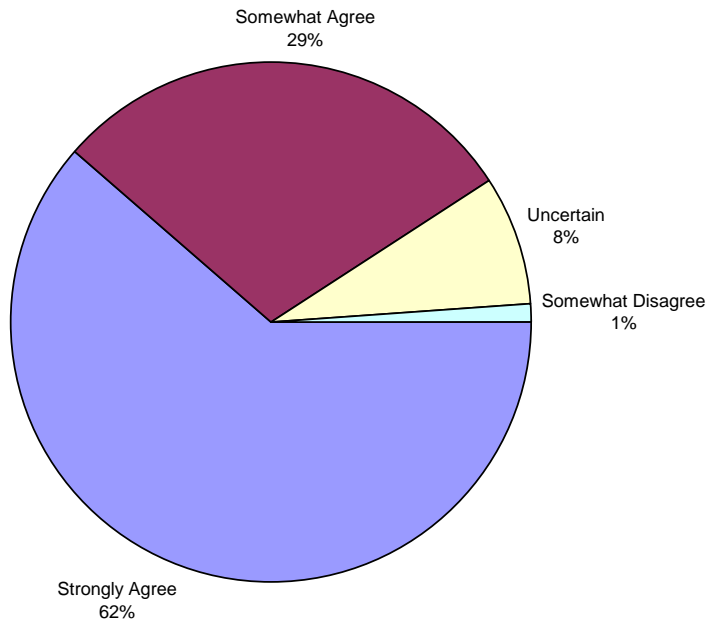
I am satisfied with the opportunities offered Purdue University students to develop aspects of the Christian Life (involvement in liturgy opportunities for community service).



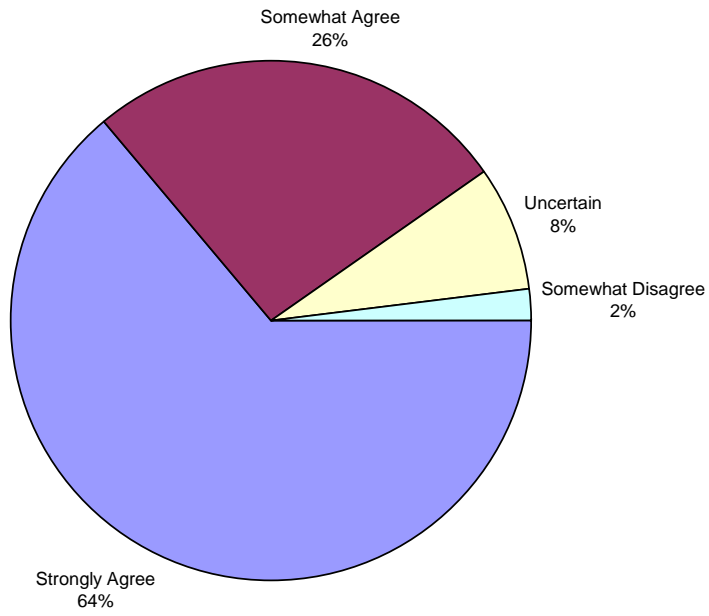
